## EMPLOYEES: WHAT SHOULD I DO?

IF YOU WERE EXPOSED **TO COVID-19** 

IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

**IF YOU HAVE A POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULT** 

Regardless of vaccination status, you must **monitor for** symptoms for at least 5 days. There is no need to quarantine if no symptoms are present.

Do not come to campus while experiencing symptoms, regardless of vaccination status.

Regardless of vaccination status, you may return to work if symptoms are improving and no fever for 24 hours

Seek a COVID-19 test.

Contact your doctor if your symptoms worsen.

## Seek a COVID-19 test.

The CDC recommends continue monitoring for symptoms and wearing a mask for **10 days**.

Contact your supervisor to make accommodations. You **do not** have to divulge the specific reason you are ill or isolating.

If **COVID negative**, return to normal activities after you are feeling better. If **COVID positive**, return to normal activities if symptoms improve and no fever for 24 hours.

## WHAT IF ONE OF MY STUDENTS OR **EMPLOYEES IS POSITIVE?**

- **Do not** tell other students or employees about the positive case.
- If a student or employee **asks for help**, remind them of MSU's COVID-19 guidance.
