## **Lattice Quilt**

This quilt is made by making partial seams. Follow the diagram and start in the lower left corner. Keep building the quilt toward the upper right, partial seaming all the way.

## Rotary cut

Cut 108, light squares 3" x 3". Cut 19, bright squares, 3" x 3"

Cut 88, bright rectangles 3" x 8"

For the border


Cut 2 strips, 5" x 57½", for the sides Cut 2 strips, 5" x 51½" for the top and bottom

The finished quilt is  $51\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $66\frac{1}{2}$ "

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1. Start building from the bottom left corner. Stitch one bright square and two light squares to make a strip. Sew the strip to one bright rectangle. Repeat to make another unit.
